Scholarship Program

OVERVIEW

The Center for Business Excellence awards scholarships for individuals to pursue training for a period not to exceed twelve months at local approved training vendors.

Scholarships through the Center for Business Excellence (CBE) are provided on a competitive basis when all other resources have been exhausted.

Scholarship allocations vary by year and type of training requested.

Scholarships are awarded based on individual need.

The outcome expected of training is employment.

SCHOLARSHIP TIMELINE (DUE DATES)*

April 15, July 15, November 15

*dates are subject to change

GUIDELINES AND RESTRICTIONS

Applicants must meet CBE eligibility requirements.

Applicants may choose from any school on approved vendor list.

Applicants who have received training sponsored through the One-Stop System may not be eligible for any other sponsored training.

Applicants must pursue all other available sources of funding (scholarships, grants, including the PELL) for tuition assistance and must provide proof of continued self-support during training.

Training is only provided in occupations listed on the Targeted Occupation List.

CBE will determine the scholarship level.

CBE cannot reimburse for costs that were incurred prior to the approval of a scholarship.

CBE will not approve payment of any out-of-state tuition.

Remediation classes and books and pre-requisites classes are not eligible for funding through CBE's scholarship program.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

What will be evaluated for your award?

- Prior training and transferable skills from previous employment
- Achieving an appropriate grade level on the Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE)
- Interest/aptitude assessment results matching your career choice
- Your ability to benefit from training
- Income level
- Personal contributions toward education, including pell grants, employment, etc.
- Your essay
- Unofficial financial aid transcripts

You will have an opportunity to discuss these criteria further with the Career Specialist.
